Conditions of Play - 2025

Green Fees

1. Green fees are to be set by and paid to players home club.

Eligibility:

1. Players who have competed in two or more Open Gr8 are ineligible for HLL. Selected as a non-playing Open Gr8 reserve does not count as a game played.
2. All players to be Full financial Members of their Club. However, in exceptional circumstances players may be loaned to another Club so that playing commitments can be completed.
3. Matches may be played on or before the weekend allocated or at a different time by arrangement. If no such arrangement can be agreed upon, then the match shall be played on the Saturday afternoon at 1.00 pm for Ladies and Men.

Scoring:

1. 1 point per rink win. In the event of a draw on any rink each team shall receive 0.5 point.
2. 1 point for an overall win. Total points, 5 men, 3 ladies.
3. If rink points are tied 2 all for men or 1 all for ladies, the overall point shall be decided by points margin. If still tied, then each team shall receive 0.5 point.

Bench Players:

1. Each team may have up to 2 "Bench Players".
2. A Bench Player may replace any player at the completion of an end at any time during the match.
3. "Retired" players are unable to re-commence play except due to illness of another team member.

Results and Tables:

1. It is the responsibility of the host club to scan and email results sheet to: bphllresults@gmail.com. Please take care when completing the results sheet, and email on the game day to ensure a timely notification of overall results.
2. Results and tables will be displayed on the BPHLL website (www.bphll.au) and Nambour Bowls Club website, www.nambourbowlsclub.com.au from Tuesday noon.

Length of Games:

1. No game shall exceed 3 hours and 30 minutes.
2. If a game continues beyond 3 hours and 30 minutes, a bell will ring to indicate the end of the match. Any rinks still competing will complete the end started before the bell. An end killed after the bell shall not be replayed.

Interruptions to play:

1. If the weather is inclement then teams should travel and a decision on play made 1 hour after the scheduled start of play. Common sense should prevail in the case of obvious washouts and other circumstances.
2. If no play is possible then all points and prize money will be shared between the clubs involved. The match will not be re-scheduled. (Please refer to the Bowls Queensland Heat Policy.)
3. If play is interrupted and not completed within 3 hours and 30 minutes, then the following conditions apply:

Fours:

14 or more completed ends will constitute a game.

3 bowl Triples:

10 or more completed ends will constitute a game.

Pairs:

4 Bowls 12 or more completed ends will constitute a game.

3 Bowls 16 or more completed ends will constitute a game.

NB: All games are to be played in accordance with the rules and guidelines of Bowls Qld.
